In 2008, the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) has launched the "Exchange Program for East Asian Young Researchers." Aimed at promoting of researcher exchanges with East Asian countries, this program supports initiatives by Japanese universities and research institutions to invite young researchers (e.g., master's and doctoral students and postdoctoral researchers) from those countries.

At the Second East Asia Summit (EAS), held in January 2007, Mr. Shinzo Abe, then Prime Minister of Japan, announced a plan to implement a youth exchange program, inviting about 6,000 young people to Japan mainly from the EAS member states every year for the next five years. Based on this plan, the Government of Japan has launched the Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youths (JENESYS) Programme, under which it is conducting a variety of exchange activities.

As a part of the JENESYS Programme, the Exchange Program for East Asian Young Researchers works to create regional cooperation among Asian countries through exchanges of next generation researchers.

By supporting exchange programs implemented by Japanese universities and research institutions, the program works to establish and expand networks with researchers mainly from Asian countries. It also helps to develop high-caliber human resources and to create a regional science and technology community. Countries Covered: ASEAN-member countries (Indonesia, Cambodia, Singapore, Thailand, Philippines, Brunei, Vietnam, Malaysia, Myanmar and Laos), Australia, New Zealand and India.
