## Program with Quality Assurance


Quality assurance of education, PDCA cycle for improvement and development

Strict evaluation control, study plan and quality standard of graduation, credit transfer

Ensure mutual exchange of written UCTS study program and promote a new UCTS made in cooperation with the domestic AIMS partner institutions. Furthermore, implement a 4-grade evaluation to measure the achievement of global competency and promote and check the internship by e-portfolio and Skype.
