


Development of Exploratory COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) Programs toward Human Security and Multicultural Coexistence

(Summary of Exchange Program)

The Project aims to foster academic and educational cooperation between U.S. and Japanese universities through distant learning and exchange programs, utilizing Collaborative Online International Learning (COIL). Three universities from Japan and ten institutions from U.S. participate to (1) provide globally connected educational opportunities, (2) enhance multi-faceted student mobility programs, which incorporate resources from partner institutions and local societies, and (3) contribute toward elimination of educational inequality through COIL for students in developing counties.



(Global Human Resources of the Project)

Students who will explore issues in International Society from the perspective of human security and multicultural coexistence, as well as, contribute to finding solutions.

[Feature of the Project]

- 1. Use of COIL to expand opportunities of international cooperative learning and to increase educational opportunities for diverse student body
- 2. Multi-faceted student mobility programs that incorporate resources from partner institutions and local societies
- 3. Three-Campus Study Programs, in which three universities provide unique educational contents
- 4. Application of COIL to provide educational opportunities for students in developing countries
