Global COE Program for FY2007 grants, Selection results

For FY 2007 grants, JSPS received 281 applications from national, public and private universities in February. The Category-specific Subcommittee established in each of the five program categories (Life sciences; Chemistry, material sciences; Information sciences, electrical and electronic sciences; Humanities; and Interdisciplinary, combined fields, new disciplines) under the Global COE Program Committee conducted document reviews, hearings and panel reviews.

In the selection process, document reviews were conducted using as reference the overall evaluation and comments of Japanese ad hoc reviewers (about two per application; total of 514 researchers) to screen the applications and select those to be forwarded for hearings and panel reviews.

The hearings and panel reviews were conducted using as reference the overall evaluation and comments of the foreign ad hoc reviewers (about two per application; total of 139 researchers) to evaluate the proposed COE programs' potential to build a more internationally competitive university.

Based on the above process, the final decision on grant selections was made by the Global COE Program Committee at its 7 June meeting. The results were as follows;

Life sciences: 13; Chemistry, material sciences: 13; Information sciences, electrical and electronic sciences: 13; Humanities: 12; Interdisciplinary, combined fields, new disciplines: 12
