## Screening Criteria

### Screening criteria

- 1) Visit expected to advance research and/or contribute to creating, sustaining and/or strengthening scientific networks between Sweden and Japan.
- 2) Good pre-visit communication between applicant and proposed host researcher and a concrete activity plan established between them.
- 3) In addition to the host institution, visits will be made to a few other institutions for the purpose of engaging in discussions, giving lectures, or conducting other activities. Education-oriented activities may be included such as exchanging views with young Japanese researchers.
- 4) As much as possible, no preference is to be given to the applicant's age, specialty or hosting institution.




Note: In conducting these screening, care should be taken not to leak the applicants' personal information.

### Bridge Fellow Eligibility

- Be a researcher who is employed as an active researcher working at a university or a research institute.
- Be a researcher who has experienced research in Japan under a JSPS program and who is currently a regular member of an officially recognized JSPS alumni association.
- Agreement by host researcher to all seven items of support in Form B (Agreement by Host Researcher).
