




BRIDGE Fellowship Program

Rules for Nominating Committee Members

1. The Committee will be formed by the Executive Members/ Life Members of the Association from different disciplines.
2. Chair of the Nominating/Selection Committee will be the Vice-President-1 or Vice-President-2 of BJSPSAA.
3. Bridge Fellows Nominating Committee will be comprised of five members including Chair.
4. Each committee works for only one fiscal year (FY) and reform for new FY.
5. Committee will be formed in Executive Committee (EC) meeting but if any member cannot attend the meeting, the Committee may co-opt another one from the EC.
6. Director, JSPS Bangkok office, will be a member of the nominating committee or will nominate a representative from the Embassy of Japan in Bangladesh as a member of the nominating committee.

<Instruction>

The alumni association, in coordination with JSPS offices**, is to establish rules and procedures with regard to the below-listed items. They should, then, be sent to JSPS for approval as indicated in the Application Guidelines.

**For alumni associations without a JSPS overseas office in their country, coordination is carried out with “the JSPS-designated embassy official.”

Necessary items in rules regarding BRIDGE Fellowship nominating committee members

- 1) Qualifications of committee members
- 2) Method of selecting committee members, and the fixed number of members on the committee
- 3) Term of committee members, and method of filling vacancies should they occur
- 4) Method of selecting committee chair
- 5) Method of replacing committee chair should s/he step down during tenure
- 6) Inclusion of JSPS office director on committee, if there is a JSPS office in the alumni association’s country

For alumni associations without a JSPS overseas office in their country, the JSPS-designated Embassy official should serve as a member of the nominating committee.
