Screening Criteria

Candidates are evaluated and selected for JSPS bridge fellowship program based on the following criteria

1	Contribution to Alumni	40
2	International activity: Joint international projects, international conferences,	25

3	Ongoing cooperation with Japanese researcher(s): Current projects,	25
	publications, exchange visits & etc.	
4	Full publications list in leading national and international journals

Points to be noted:

- 1. Candidate should be a member of the Alumni association and has been paid the annual membership fees.
- 2. Candidates who have been awarded JSPS fellowship can be eligible.
- 3. Members who have joined the Alumni Association after the announcement of Bridge Fellowship program shall not be eligible for consideration for this year's round.
- 4. Priority will be given to candidates who are currently working inside Egypt and are attending the interview. However, if candidates are not available in this category, then preference shall be given to others.
- 5. Members who have completed JSPS bridge fellowship should spent at least 5 years to be eligible for consideration for this year's round. Once there are more than candidate, priority shall be given to those who didn't have bridge before.
