Rules for Nominating Committee Members

1) Qualifications of committee members

The nominating committee should consist of the president of JSPSAAE, the director of JSPS Cairo Research Station and two Japanese vice-presidents from Egypt Japan University of Science and Technology, Egypt

2) Method of selecting committee members, and the number of members on the committee

Regarding above, the fixed number is four.

3) Term of committee members, and method of filling vacancies should they occur

Term of committee members should be the term of his/her term of office. From Egypt Japan University of Science and Technology, Egypt some person could join. For the vacancy of JSPSAAE President, the vice-president of JSPSAAE should be the member of committee, and for the vacancy of director of JSPS Cairo Research Station, the person from Embassy of Japan, Egypt should be the member of committee,

4) Method of selecting committee chair

The chair should be the person the director of JSPS Cairo Research Station.

5) Method of replacing committee chair should she/he step down during tenure

Other person from Embassy of Japan will be the member of committee.

6) Inclusion of JSPS office director on committee, if there is a JSPS office in the alumni association's country.

The alumni association, in coordination with JSPS offices**, is to establish rules and procedures with regard to the below-listed items. They should, then, be sent to JSPS for approval as indicated in the Application Guidelines.

**For alumni associations without a JSPS overseas office in their country, coordination is carried out with “the JSPS-designated embassy official.”
