## BRIDGE Fellowship

### Screening Criteria

- 1) Visit should contribute to creating, sustaining and/or strengthening scientific networks between German-speaking countries (Germany, Austria, Switzerland, and Luxemburg) and Japan.
- 2) Visit expected to advance research and/or contribute to creating, sustaining and/or strengthening scientific networks.
- 3) Good pre-visit communication between the applicant and proposed host researcher and a concrete activity plan established between them.
- 4) In addition to the host institution, visits will be made to several other institutions for the purpose of engaging in discussions, giving lectures, or conducting other activities. Education-oriented activities may be included such as exchanging views with young Japanese researchers.
- 5) Generally, no preference is to be given to the applicant's age, specialty, or destination institution. However, among equally qualified applications preference might be given to those who have never revisited Japan through the Bridge program or those who are at the beginning of their carrier.

Note: In conducting these screening, care should be taken not to leak the applicant's personal information.
