Screening Criteria

- Alumni member's contribution to boost India-Japan relations and to spread the awareness of JSPS, his interest to increase collaboration between India and Japan would be the main criteria.
- 2. For considering the Bridge Fellowship, Indian JSPS Alumni Member should have minimum 5 year gap for retirement.
- 3. IJAA will consider the members who is working in India for minimum 5 years after returning back from Japan.
- 4. While submitting his/her application for the Bridge Fellowship, Alumni member should submit a separate application form created by IJAA, to assess the applicant's contribution to IJAA activities as well as India-Japan relations.
- Applicant should submit "No Objection Certificate" from his institution, saying that, if he/she receive the Bridge Fellowship, then the institution will allow him to take up the fellowship. Persons who will not submit this form will not be considered.
- 6. JSPS alumni member's contribution to his/her research field will assess before providing Bridge Fellowship.
