- 3. General Secretary of Indian JSPS Alumni Association
- 4. Official representing JSPS in the Japanese embassy in India, Delhi

Indian JSPS Alumni Association's Chair will be the Chairman of the Bridge Nominating Committee Chairman. If he is stepping down, (from the chairman position of Indian JSPS Alumni Association) from the position then the Vice Chairman of Indian JSPS Alumni will become the member of the nominating committee and Chairman of the Bridge committee until new chairman.

This same above rule will be applicable to the position of General Secretary Indian JSPS Association's Bridge fellowship program. If General Secretary is going to stepping down, until the new General Secretary selected, either one of the joint secretary's will become member of the Bridge fellowship program, who will be selected by Chairman of the Indian JSPS Alumni Association after the approval of the Executive Committee.

Person recommended by JSPS who is working in the Japanese embassy in India, Delhi will always a member of the Bridge fellowship program and in his absence, after consultation with JSPS head office, and after their recommendation position of the JSPS official will be filled.
