Screening Criteria

BRIDGE Fellow Status:

- · Must be an active researcher at a university or research institute.
- Must be a researcher who has research experience under the JSPS program in Japan and is currently a regular member of the officially recognized JSPS Korean Alumni Association.

Other screening criteria:

- 1) Ensure that it contributes to establishing, maintaining and/or strengthening scientific networks between the applicant's home country and Japan.
- 2) Ensure that the visit is expected to advance research or contribute to the creation, maintenance and/or strengthening of scientific networks.
- 3) Ensuring good pre-visit communication between the applicant and the proposed host researcher and specific action plans established between them.
- 4) For document evaluation, applicants must check the application documents, rate each applicant as P (Passage) or F (Failure), and submit their opinions.
- 5) The chairperson of the final review committee for determining recommendation rankings is discussed and decided by the committee.
- 6) Recommendation ranking is determined by the order of highest P in document evaluation.
- 7) In case of a tie, the final review committee will discuss and decide.
