Rules for Nominating Committee Members

1. Qualifications of committee members

Committee members must be members of the JSPS Korean Alumni Association.

- 2. Method of selecting committee members, and the fixed number of members on the committee. Committee members are elected through recommendations from the president of the JSPS Korean Alumni Association, and are comprised of a total of five people, including the president and the science officer of the Japanese Embassy in Korea.
- 3. Term of committee members, and method of filling vacancies should they occur

 The term of office for members is one year from December 1, 2023 to November 30, 2024. When a vacancy occurs, the chairman makes additional recommendations.
 - 4. Method of selecting committee chair

The chairman of the committee makes decisions through meetings.

5. Method of replacing committee chair should s/he step down during tenure If the chairperson resigns, the committee determines the next chairperson.

6. Committee operating regulations

- -For document evaluation, applicants must check the application documents, rate each applicant as P (Passage) or F (Failure), and submit their opinions.
- -The chairperson of the final review committee for determining recommendation rankings is discussed and decided by the committee.
- -Recommendation ranking is determined by the order of highest P in document evaluation.
- -In case of a tie, the final review committee will discuss and decide.
