Rules for Nominating Committee Members

Necessary items in rules regarding BRIDGE Fellowship nominating committee members

- 1) Qualifications of committee members:
Chair: VICE President of NJAA, Member of committee: President of NJAA, and Member of committee: Executive Member of NJAA, And Japanese embassy official (representative)
- 2) Method of selecting committee members, and the fixed number of members on the committee:
Excom Decided for it in a formal meeting.
- 3) Term of committee members and method of filling vacancies should they occur: TOR is set for the committee as per the rules of Bridge Fellowships.
- 4) Method of selecting committee chair: Excom meeting decided by a meeting.
- 5) Method of replacing committee chair should s/he step down during tenure: Not Applicable.
Inclusion of JSPS office director on committee, if there is a JSPS office in the alumni association's country: Japanese embassy official (representative) nominated by Embassy of Japan in Kathmandu, Nepal.


For alumni associations without a JSPS overseas office in their country, the JSPS-designated Embassy official should serve as a member of the nominating committee.




