BRIDGE Fellowship

Screening Criteria

1. The applicant should be able to contribute to establishing, strengthening and enhancing the scientific networks between the applicant's home country and Japan.
2. His/her visit is expected to advance research and contribute to creating, strengthening and enhancing scientific networks.
3. Good pre-visit communication between the applicant and the proposed host researcher to enable the joint development of a concrete activity plan of the applicant while in Japan.
4. In addition to the host institution, visits will be made to several other institutions to engage in discussions, deliver lectures or conduct other activities. Education-oriented activities may be included, such as exchanging views with young Japanese researchers.
5. As much as possible, no preference will be given to the applicant's age, field of specialization and/or destination institution.
6. Active participation in JAAP activities that can be measured in terms of support to outreach activities, participation in meetings and general assemblies, mobilizing the participation of other members and payment of annual membership fee etc.
7. Must be a researcher and/or academic who is employed as an active researcher working in a university or a research institution.
