

Japan Society for the Promotion of Science BRIDGE Fellowship Program Screening Criteria

1. The research proposal should show evidence of creating, sustaining or strengthening Japan-Thailand academic linkage.
2. The research proposal should have a clear plan that could progress to a stronger academic collaboration project in the future.
3. The research proposal should not be related military affairs.
4. The applicant and host researcher in Japan are required to discuss the applicant's proposed research plan in detail prior to the application being made. This plan must be well defined and the host should show clear interest in the research project.
5. A balance of applicants selected should be maintained on the basis of affiliated and host institution.
6. Contribution to the activities of the JSPS Alumni Association of Thailand shall be evaluated.
7. As much as possible, no preference shall be given to the applicants' age, gender or field of research.
8. Bridge Fellow must be a researcher who is employed as an active researcher working at a university or a research institute.

Note: In the screening process, care should be taken not to leak the applicants' personal information.
