Cooperation with Northeastern Asian Countries

Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), National Science Foundation of China (NSFC), and National Research Foundation (NRF) work as a consortium in supporting trilateral research projects that establish top-level research hubs in Asia.

A-HORCs (Heads of Research Councils in Asia)

- •A-HORCs meetings give top executives of principal science-promotion agencies in China, Korea and Japan an opportunity to meet and engage in a candid exchange of views on issues related to Science & Technology (S & T) policy in their respective countries.
- •The theme of each year's symposium and A3 Foresight Program is determined at the annual A-HORCs meeting.

- Northeastern Asian Symposium is designed to build up the scientific network and strengthen the partnership among 3 countries.
- •Under the A3 Foresight Program, proposals for joint projects are invited on topics related to that year's symposium theme.

- A3 Foresight program supports advancing research on common regional issues and fostering young researchers.
- Duration: 5 years
- Funding: up to 50 million for JPY 5years/ project
