I divided my lecture in three parts. In the first part I talked about my country: Italy, specifically about my city: Bologna. I made a geographical introduction, and I gave an overlook of the peculiarity of the region before focusing on the city of Bologna. I talked about the history of the city with a specific focus on its architecture, urban planning and the University.

In the second part of the lecture I talked about my studying background and the reason why I wanted to become a researcher. Particularly I focused on the aesthetic of the urban landscape and on how the urban planning of a city reflects the symbolic world, and the culture of the people who inhabits it. In this part I compared the urban planning of Kyoto with Rome and Bologna.

Furthermore I talked about the relationship between our body and the cityscape, and how our perception of the space is always influenced by our cultural heritage as well as our emotional state.

In the last part of my lecture I talked about my research. I explained that my research is focusing on the relationship between body and urban space and the impact that internet and NCIT (New Information and Communication Technology) have on both of them. To make it easier I presented example of students everyday life, like the impact of social network in their social relationship and how they can affect our perception of beauty. Finally I talked about the relationship between virtuality and materiality and how it evolved during time from the '80s of XX century to today.
