[Summary of Inter-University Exchange Projects] Under the theme of "SDGs x ARTs", set with the aim of contributing to the issues facing the world, this project aims 'to build an education and research program in the field of art' and 'to nurture global leaders who connect society and art,' in collaboration with leading higher education universities in the U.K., Australia, and India.

The program also aims to conclude international exchange agreements with partner universities to promote the mutual dispatch and acceptance of exchange students, having interlocal social practice projects, and to offer double degrees at the master's and doctoral levels based on international collaboration.

- 3) Attend special lectures and workshops given by faculty members of the partner universities to understand the situation of environmental issues and SDGs in various parts of the world and tackle issues from both local and global perspectives.
- Semester Program to learn about "SDGs X ART" through practical activities
- 1) Research Phase Clarify research topics and goals based on their own interests and issues
- 2) Intern Phase Participate in internships provided in ateliers, government agencies, companies, etc.
