The talk started with an introduction to my home country of Germany focusing on geography, culture, and economy. It especially highlighted German things that students might already have been exposed to but did not realise were German – such as German loanwords that exist in Japanese, Grimm's fairy tales, or large German brands. It also introduced some similarities and differences between Germany and Japan.

Next, I talked a bit about my background and academic trajectory. This served two purposes. First, since I lived in many countries in the last 10 years, it helped demonstrate to them the importance of learning English (English ability as requirement for international mobility). Second, it also served as a starting point for a discussion of academia as a career choice, which familiarized them with the work done by researchers working at universities, the skills needed for such work, and the advantages and disadvantages of this career path.

Finally, I spoke about my own research, and used this as a jumping off point for an accessible

introduction to social science research. The discussion of the social sciences as a field of researched focused on research approach and rationale. It examined the differences between the social and the natural sciences and highlight the merits and uses of social science research. This was followed by example-driven overview of the research process, focusing on qualitative research methods. It concluded with an explanation of the value of social science research.
