I prepared lecture based on the requirements and outline shared by the school teacher that consisted of four parts.

In the first part I briefly introduced myself and my home country. I gave a pictorial view of my home country (Pakistan) to offer useful insights that are often difficult to explain even in a plain language. In the second part, I explained them what is social sciences? What academic and career options one can have if they opt social sciences? How a social scientist contributes to the betterment of a society by giving very simple examples from their surroundings. In the third part, I explained them my motivation to become a social scientist in the field of business administration. I gave them insight about how different fields of business (finance, accounting, marketing, information system and human resource management) work? Why I selected human resource management and organizational behavior and how I am helping business to grow and serve a society. The session was concluded with a group activity in which I divided the class into four groups (10

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students each). The 15 minutes activity was on the team building and leadership which can help students to understand the importance of communication in team and the role of leadership in a team. The purpose of the group activity was to motivate them to be a good team player and effective communicator.

Throughout the lecture, I frequently interacted with students by asking questions, and encouraged them to have discussions.
