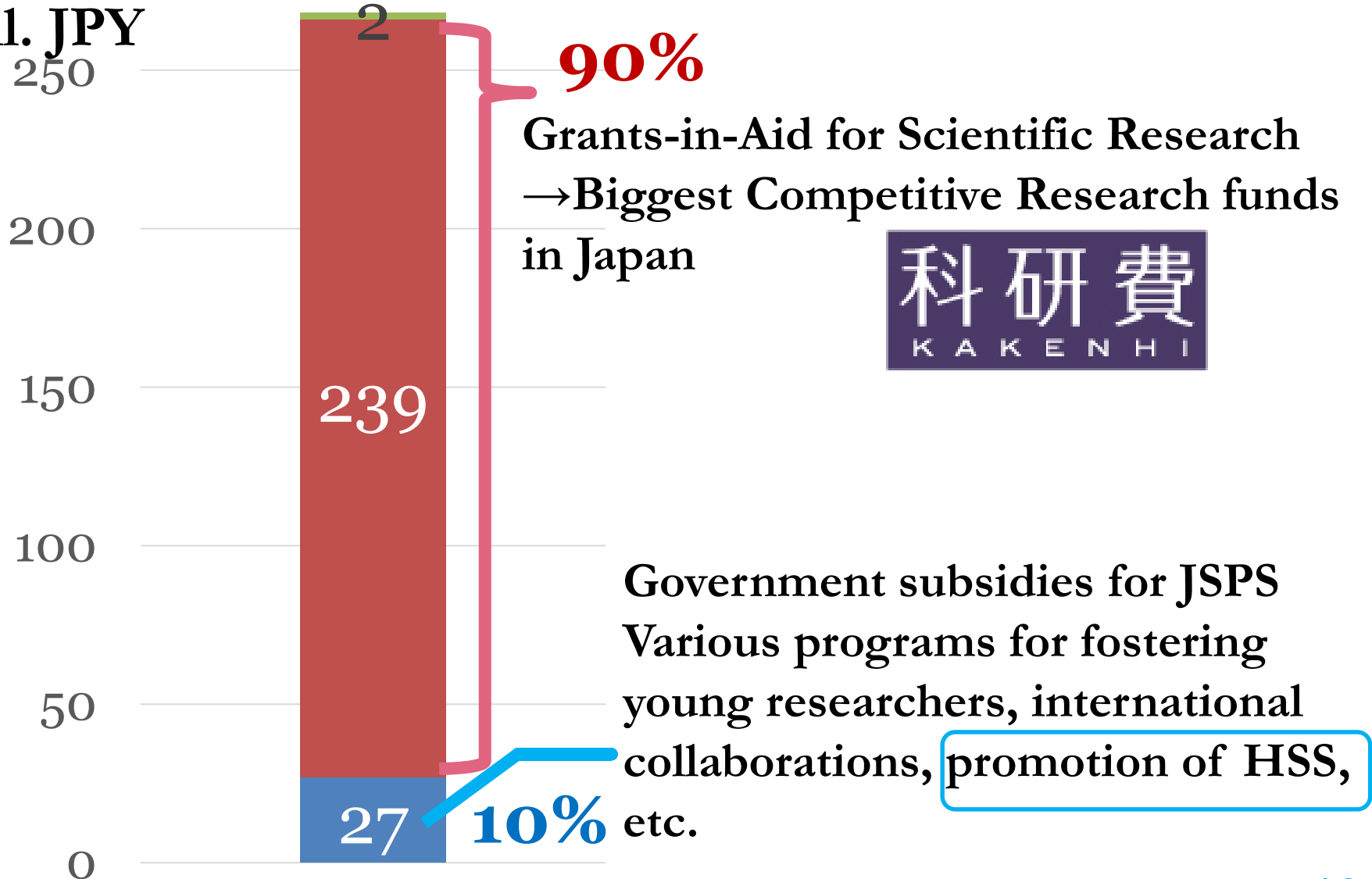

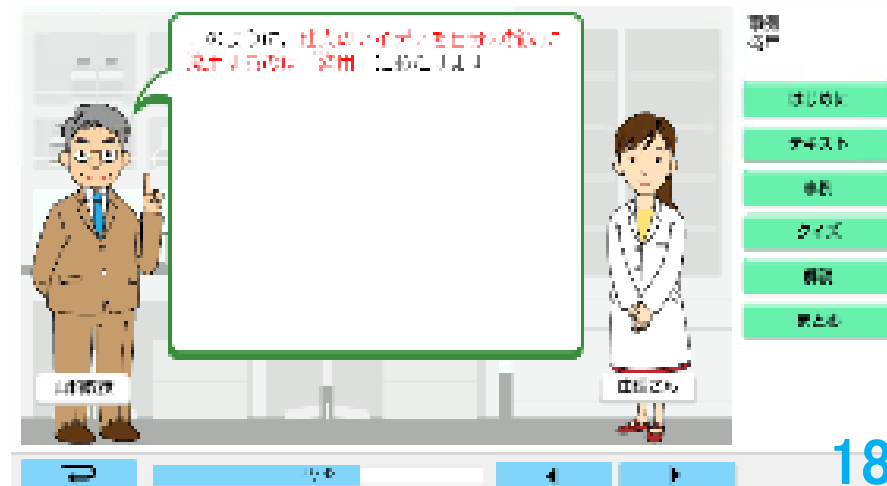


e-Learning Course on Research Ethics

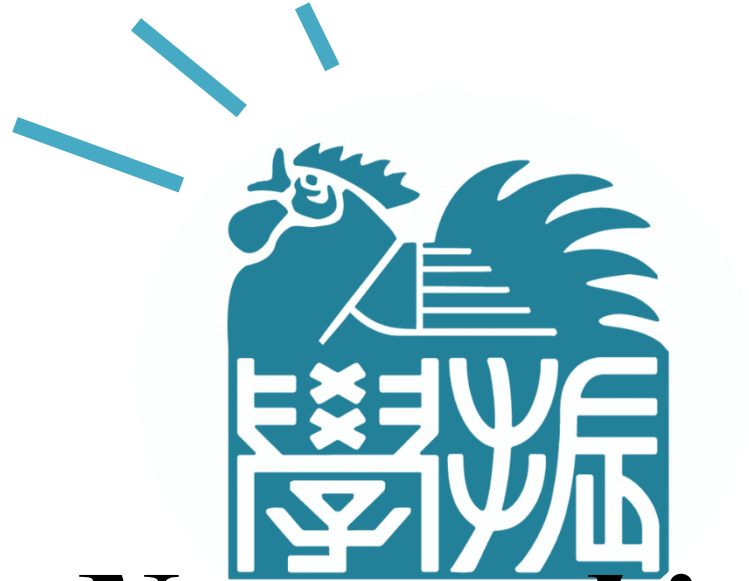
