Positive aspects

Problems

- Lack of regular interaction between

Problems

- Low attendance for events
- Most clubs and circles only have Japanese information
- Lack of outreach
- Segregation between Japanese and international students on campus

Proposals

- More ways to let students know about information
 - ✓ Bilingual newsletter
- Expose students to international exchange
 - ✓ Campus life would improve if there is more interaction
- Find a leader

Proposals

- More initiative from international students
- More international events on regular basis
- Active newsletter for international students

- More meeting space
 - ✓ Utilize these space with events
- Find sponsors
- Direct access to university president
 - ✓ Example: SCIKyu in Kyushu University
- More support from university
