This lecture was divided into three parts: (1) my education experience in the US and UK, (2) my motivation for becoming a researcher, and (3) an overview of the field of international education and thoughts on my recent research in Bhutan. My lecture emphasised my own personal experiences, particularly those that led me to the PhD program at Oxford University and the importance of my practical research experience in the field of international development and education policy. Finally, I provided photos that I found interesting of my recent fieldwork in the remote region of Gasa in Bhutan. The research aspect of my lecture focused on broad trends in international education and provided a background as well as some specific points about my research.
