- Lecture summary (講義概要): Please summarize your lecture within 200-500 words.

I was requested by the school to talk about my country, reason for becoming a 'scientist', and my research. The first part of my presentation focused on introducing myself and my culture. I explained my interests and hobbies, my city and country, and the stages of my life which led to my current research. I made the lesson interactive by asking students questions throughout the presentation. After a 10 minute break, I introduced students to various aspects of my research. I spoke about the field of environmental ethics, practical environmental problems, the main theoretical problem of Anthropocentrism, responses to this problem such as Ecocentrism and Deep Ecology, how Asian philosophy can contribute to this problem, introduced Watsuji Tetsurō's ethical thought, and discussed symbiosis as a resolution. I also played a short video about the relationship between humans and nature in Japan in order to contextualise discussion, and asked the students to think about some questions and prepare answers. I then asked some students for their answers, and provided time for students to ask any questions that they wanted. The students asked questions based on the presentation and for my own ideas on the questions I had asked them. After the lesson, I was taken to the Principal's office and 'interviewed' by two students who were also passionate about environmental ethics.
