



【Summary of Inter-University Exchange Project】



【Summary of exchange program】

Nagasaki University advocates "Planetary Health" and has launched a new "Program for Planetary Health" which aims to develop a university-wide education and research system and develop human resources in order to respond to and contribute to global problems. Above all, our university, which has a long history with Africa, is promoting the development of human resources that will focus on the issues of medical health and security in Africa and interactions between Nagasaki University and Kenya. This program consists of (1) online exchange program, (2) short-term training program, (3) long-term training program, (4) symposium program, and (5) internship program. In regards to (2) through (5), participants must travel to Japan / Kenya. This program includes on-the-job exchange and human resource development programs for the realization of global health from a new perspective.

【Global human resource project outcomes】

This program will provide graduates who can be:

- Bridges between Japan and Africa, who can take leadership responsibilities, and develop friendship activities
- Scientists who can flexibly adopt new technologies, and innovative ideas to solve global issues
- Practitioners who can understand the environmental and cultural differences between Japan and Africa, think together about issues related to planetary health, and engage in activities to solve them
- Organizers who can spontaneously and sustainably develop the community formed by the PHASE Program

【Features of the project】

In this program, students from Japan and Africa will share each other's values and beliefs through culture, society, and language. Students aim to acquire the ability to think about and implement efforts to solve global problems by working together on social issues. In order to gradually understand the differences in the completely different environments and cultures of Japan and Africa and start dialogues, students first complete the online "break-in" program. After that, we deepen exchanges with short-term training field trips to remote islands and areas and long-term training that focuses on research activities centered on each student's specialized field such as medicine, health science, and sociology. This program will focus on expanding each individual student's specialty from another perspective so that they can carry out research that can contribute to planetary health.
