

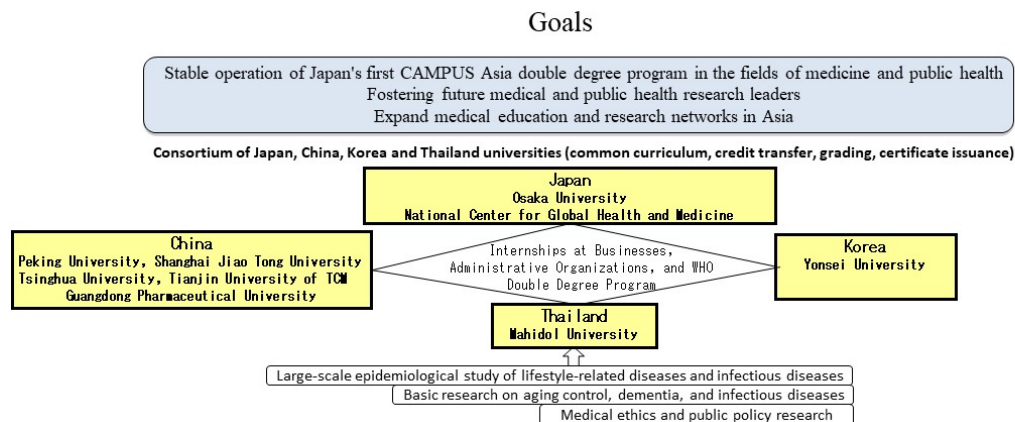

Nurturing of medical and public health research leaders to solve health problems in global societies

【Summary of Inter-University Exchange Projects】



【Summary of Exchange program】

It is recognized that health problems cannot be solved by one country alone, as exemplified by the COVID-19 pandemic worldwide. It is crucial to establish a system that can cope with global health problems across borders and regions. Osaka University is operating the CAMPUS Asia program to build a network of top-level researchers who contribute to global society and to cultivate research leaders who can play an active role in local communities. The program has been conducted in collaboration with universities in China (Peking University, Tsinghua University, Shanghai Jiao Tong University, Tianjin University of Traditional Chinese Medicine) and Korea (Yonsei University). We intend to expand the project to the ASEAN region to address the threat of infectious diseases and to enhance medical education programs. From FY2021, we welcomed the following institutions to this consortium: Mahidol University (Thailand), Guangdong Pharmaceutical University (China), National Center for Global Health and Medicine (Japan), and Research Institute for Microbial Diseases and Graduate School of Medicine, Division of Health Sciences of Osaka University.

【Global Human Resource on the project】

We aim to cultivate medical and public health leaders with communicative proficiency in global health who will provide leadership to solve complex health problems in East Asia.

【Feature on the project】

This project is unique in terms of nurturing global leaders in the medical sciences and public health fields to solve global health problems as well as growing health problems in Asia, particularly communicable diseases such as COVID-19, non-communicable diseases (lifestyle-related diseases) such as cardiovascular diseases, dementia, and other age-related diseases. No other project has aimed for the double degree program in the fields of medical sciences and public health.

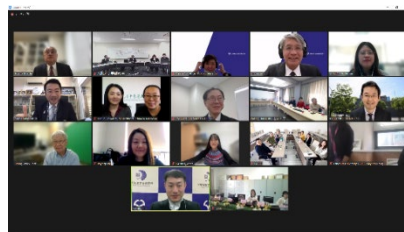

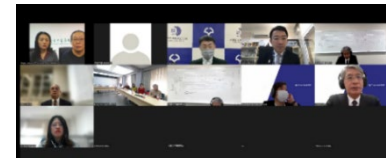
Student-Mobility

Outbound

While outbound short- and medium-term in-person exchange was canceled because of the COVID-19 pandemic, 1 student was newly sent to Yonsei University from Osaka University under the Double Degree Program (DDP). In total, 2 DDP students are studying at Yonsei University. Online CAMPUS Asia (CA) activities were held as well. In August 2021, 32 students participated in the International Public Health Seminar, and in March 2022, 6 students participated in the CA International Symposium from Osaka University.

Inbound

Although inbound short- and medium-term in-person exchange was also canceled, 1 student from Peking University applied for and enrolled in the DDP at Osaka University. In total, 3 DDP students are studying at Osaka University. For online activity, a total of 42 students (Peking University: 5, Tsinghua University: 3, Tianjin University of Traditional Chinese Medicine: 13, Shanghai Jiao Tong University: 7, Guangdong Pharmaceutical University: 13, and Yonsei University: 1) participated in the International Symposium in March 2022.

Forming the University Network with Quality Assurance

The CAMPUS Asia Academic Affairs Committee consists of faculty members of the CA Collaborative Departments. CA endeavored to improve the evaluation system to guarantee the quality assurance of the program, such as using common grading standards and formats among participating universities. In addition, the number of Collaborative Departments will be increased to meet the diverse needs of students.

Promotion of Student-Mobility Environment

The CA office of each university works closely to create and manage exchange programs. To give full support and promote the student-mobility environment, CA matches the exchange department and professor according to the student's preferences, provides necessary information, processes documentation, conducts professor interviews, makes travel arrangements, gives crisis management and course consultations, and offers life and language learning.

Internationalization of the university, Information disclosure and Publication of outcome

To disseminate programs domestically and internationally, the CA website was launched and has been updated with information on exchange programs, the status of exchange, and announcements and reports of CA events such as international symposiums and seminars. In order to focus on PR for overseas students, collaboration with Overseas Centers will become a future initiative, especially the East Asian Center for Academic Initiatives and ASEAN Center for Academic Initiatives.

Good Practices

A joint China-Japan-Korea-Thailand online international symposium and workshop was held in March 2022. Faculty members from the consortium universities gave lectures and members of the CAMPUS Asia Alumni Association Constitution presented their research. In the workshop, students from several countries exchanged opinions with each other, and on the final day, group representatives gave presentations to share their achievements with all the exchange students.
