

# (Summary of Exchange program)

This project will offer study tours (2-4 weeks), short-term (1-3 months) and long-term (6-12 months) programs for students from Gifu University, our domestic partner university, and the Australian universities mentioned above. All programs include internships, international online lectures, and a student symposium. The student symposium will invite Southeast Asian academic partner universities to participate along with Japanese and Australian students. In addition to recognition of post-SDG challenges in the world, specialized knowledge and various technologies and information in each field, we provide international joint education to solve problems by using cross-disciplinary knowledge that transcends the boundaries of the humanities and sciences.

#### [Global Human Resource on the project]

We will cultivate human resources "professionals who can work autonomously and collaboratively to contribute to economic security in a post-SDGs world" with an interdisciplinary research orientation and a glocal (bird's eye view and multifaceted) perspective, and the ability to return and share the results of their research with society.

#### **(**Feature on the project**)**

In April 2020, Nagoya University merged with Gifu University to form the Tokai National Higher Education and Research System. In this program, taking advantage of the unique characteristics of both universities, the universities, local community, and industry will collaborate to conduct study tours, short-term and long-term student exchange programs, and a student symposium. The partner universities in this exchange program have already concluded academic exchange agreements with each other, and have experienced collaboration in education and research, building relationships of trust, and promoting many personnel exchanges. This project will develop student exchange programs based on the university's new internationalization strategy and promote the establishment of a strong cooperative system.
